What is a Senior Spotlight?

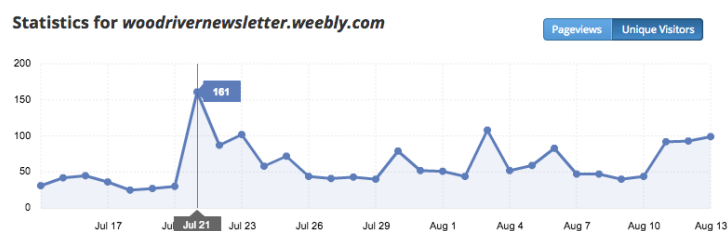

Where Will This Be Published?

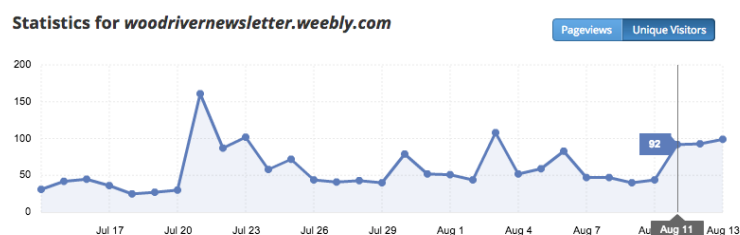

Ms. Moore made a post on August 11th, and 92 people visited that day. You can see that even on days when posts are not made, the website still generates traffic.

- create links to other websites
- upload a video
- link to a Youtube video
- upload audio
- upload a file or document
- create a poll or survey
